- The **Center on Community Living and Careers** partners with schools and support organizations to improve secondary transition and employment outcomes for individuals to live, work, and participate in their communities.



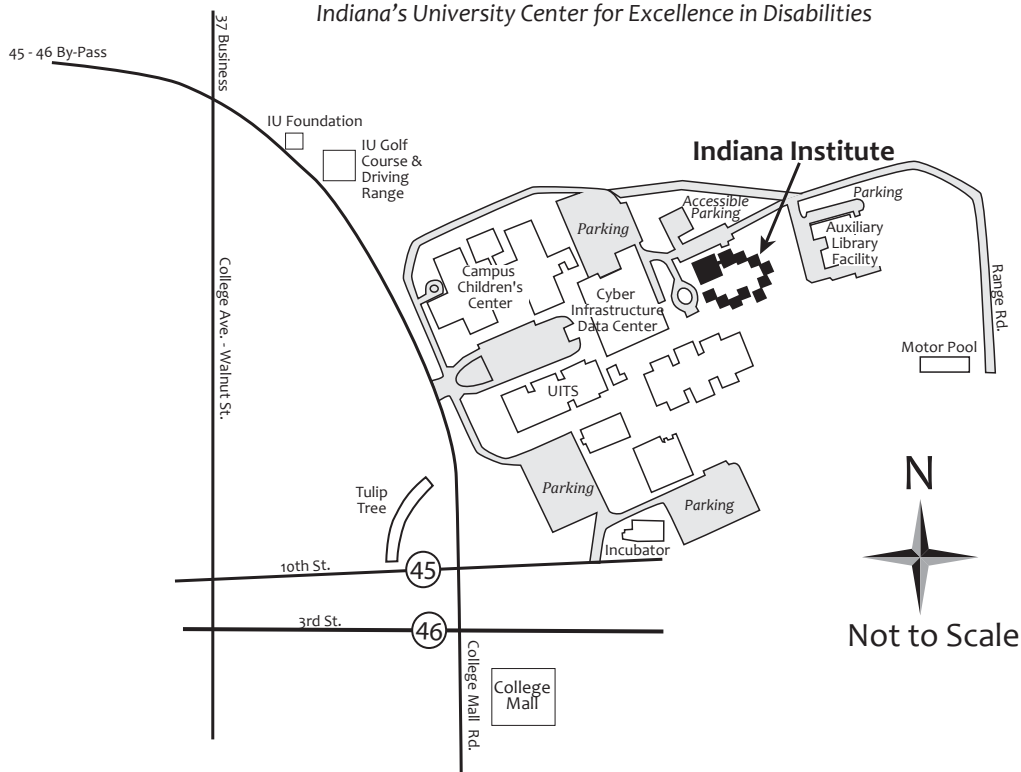
- The **Center on Aging and Community** promotes self-determination and social integration of aging adults with disabilities through participatory research, planning, and advocacy.

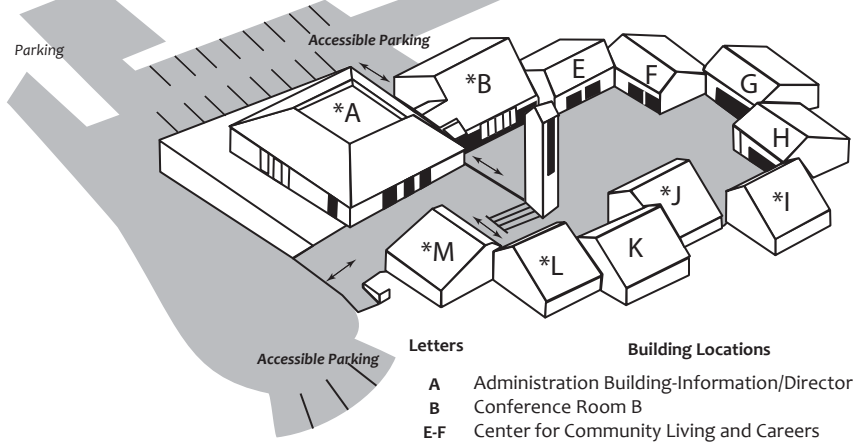
- The **Indiana Resource Center for Autism** conducts training, consultations, engages in research, and disseminates information to build local community capacity to support children and adults on the autism spectrum.
