OVERVIEW

This online course presents the history, diagnosis, prevalence and etiology of autism spectrum disorders, and introduces the strategies of 24 evidence-based practices. There are 8 modules consisting PowerPoint presentations and reading materials. Also, each module consists of pre-test, post-test questions that are multiple choice, true/false or fill in the blank.

A module is worth 2 hours of training; completion of the course is equal to 16 hours of instructional hours. It is required to show improvement from the pre-test to the post-test and achieve 90% or higher score on the post-test. You can repeatedly take the test until you meet the requirement. At the beginning, middle, and end of the course there are information gathering evaluations to provide feedback on content and organization of the online course.

Following completion of the tests and evaluations for all of the modules, a personalized certificate of attendance for 16 instructional hours will be sent to you electronically for your own records to be used to fulfill licensure requirements.
