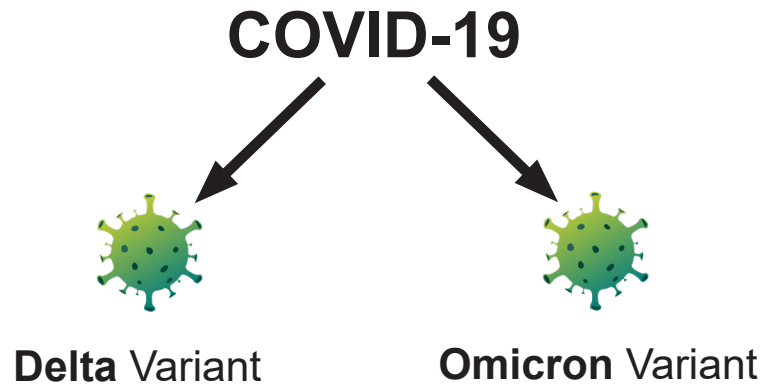


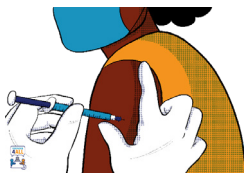
COVID-19: About the Omicron Variant
