



Instructions to Access: *Comprehensive Programming for Students Across the Autism Spectrum Training Series*

Thank you for registering through IU Conferences for our IRCA *Comprehensive Programming for Students Across the Autism Spectrum Training Series*. The following instructions will walk you through the process of creating an IU guest account, enrolling in the course now that you have purchased the course(s), accessing the course in IU Canvas, and receiving your certificate of completion in your IU Expand Dashboard once completing all requirements. Also, you cannot advance to the next course until you have completed each course in sequential order. Each will become unlocked in your IU Expand dashboard as you progress.

Let's get started!

1. Look in your email for a confirmation email from iuconfs@indiana.edu for the link to get started. The link can also be found on the registration form.
 - a. If you do not see the link, first look in your junk/spam mail.
 - b. If you still do not see the link, did someone else from the office register you? If so, ask this person to check his/her email for the link to share with you.
 - c. If no one has the link, email Julia Deaton julhille@iu.edu for assistance.

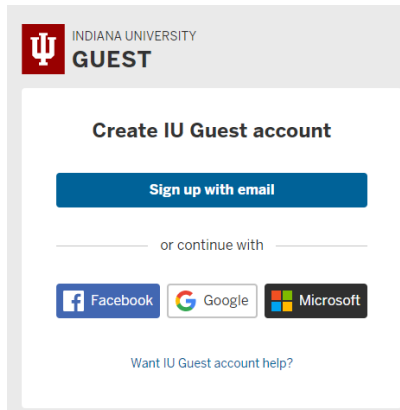
3. You're in IU Expand now. To Login:

a. If you have an IU Guest Account:

i. Click the blue words "log in" to type in your username and passphrase.

b. If you do not have an IU account, you must create an IU Guest account.

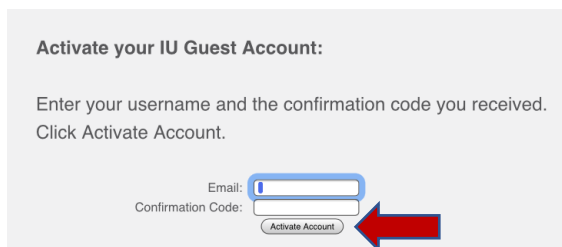
i. Click the blue box, "Sign up with email" or continue with Facebook, Google, or Microsoft to create an account.



ii. Follow the prompts to create your IU guest account. It will ask for a full email address, first and last name, and create a new password (follow password guidelines). Then click "Create Account".

iii. After you create an IU account, you will receive an activation message to the email address you provided. **You will have 10 days to activate your account. Notice there is a confirmation code which you will be asked to use along with your username (copy this code).** Then, to open the page that will activate your account, click the link in the message.

iv. On the "Activate your IU Guest Account" page, enter your full email address you provided and the confirmation code you copied.



v. Click "Activate Account". (You must activate your account for your guest account to work). You should receive a message saying, "Success – Account Activated".

4. Once you create your guest account, use the link provided in your email from **Step 1**. Follow these instructions to complete your enrollment.

5. Click on the “ENROLL” in the Program button.

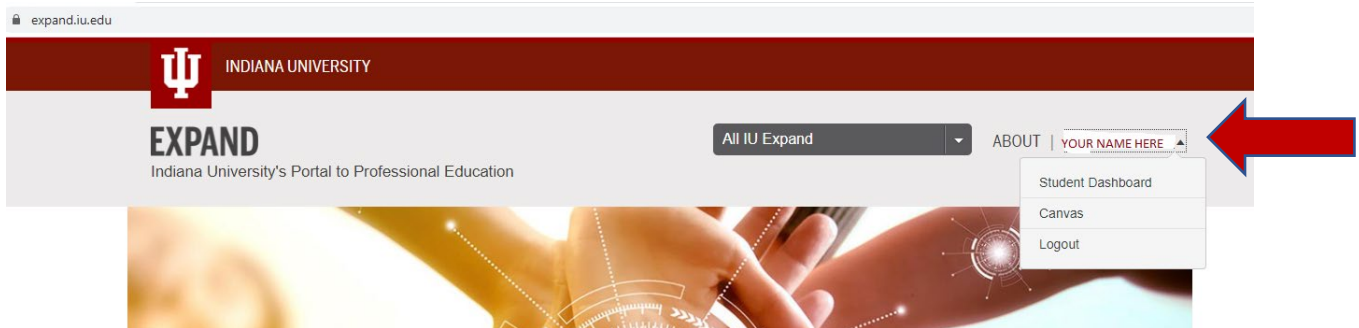
Course Overview
