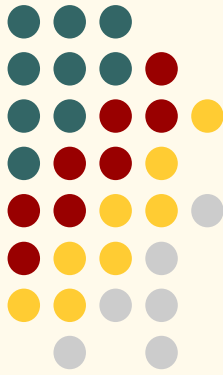


# 2015 Indiana Benefits Information Network Liaison Training



Accurate, up-to-date information about work incentives and state and federal benefits is essential for Indiana Vocational Rehabilitation Services customers and their families. Benefits Information Network (BIN) liaisons are a cadre of Indiana-certified professionals, providing individuals, families and disability service providers around the state with expertise and the basis for better planning and support.

## Who Should Attend BIN Training?

Indiana Vocational Rehabilitation Services encourages all Indiana agencies with a Purchase of Services Agreement and all Employment Networks to participate in the Benefits Information Network (BIN).

Candidates for competency-based BIN training:

- ◆ are familiar with supported employment services
- ◆ enjoy networking
- ◆ are adept at information gathering
- ◆ are able to implement and track benefits information
- ◆ can provide support services to VRS customers throughout the next year.

Continuing Education Units (CEUs) will be available for Basic BIN trainings and for BIN Recertification.

Basic training is required for first-time certification or second-year recertification. This training includes four full days of instruction, training exercises, competency tests, and a field assignment. All parts of the training are required for certification.

*Note: For Basic certification, participants must complete the training with 80% proficiency in order to be certified. Certification valid for Indiana.*

(formerly "Advanced" Training)

*Must take if certified more than 2 years.*

*Note: Participants in BIN Recertification Training are required to complete a competency assignment and earn at least 80% on an assessment test once they have finished the course. Certification is valid for Indiana.*
