Job postings are also available on the FSOSI and BRS website.</p> <p>SLP from Cluster I AT, who was helping to cover Cluster F assessments resigned.</p> <p>2) Proposal for allowing DT to be one member of the AT for this age group has been written. SPOE Supervisor discussed the proposal and presented DRAFT at the Agency meeting Feb. 10, 2015 and 3 Agency representatives were in agreement this proposal would benefit the areas they serve and their provider enrollment.
