

Procedures for diapering children three (3) years of age and older

- (1) Must not use two's, toddlers, or infant's diaper changing table or their room/area to change diapers.
- (2) Use a designated sanitized table or cot which is not used for any other purpose. The designated cot must be stored away from children when not in use and both the cot and table must be sanitized with a 1 tablespoon of bleach solution to 1 quart of water after each use.
- (3) Use the same skin care procedures as consulting physician has approved for other diapered children in a center, or follow the procedure recommended by the Indiana State Department of Health.
- (4) Soiled diapers must be placed in a tightly lidded container and emptied daily.
- (5) Child may stand while diaper is being changed if it accommodates the child and care giver effectively.
- (6) Because this child is older, it is recommended that the diapering process be done in a private area and away from other children.
- (7) The diapering process must take place within 10 feet of a hand washing sink.

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
