



Discovering Personal Genius: The Discovery Practice That Yields Employment Results

Patty Cassidy, M.Ed., is a senior associate with Griffin-Hammis Associates, LLC, providing training and technical assistance on employment to projects and agencies so they can create better employment outcomes for people with significant disabilities. Patty is a former employment specialist, working with adults and transition-aged youth through the School-to-Work Alliance Program in Colorado; she was director of supported employment for community rehabilitation programs in Virginia, Indiana, and Colorado, responsible for managing, recruiting, and training employment staff, and the funding collaboration and fiscal management of large community employment programs. Patty is an approved trainer for the Association of Community Rehabilitation Educators (ACRE) customized employment curriculum.



This one-day workshop introduces **community employment providers, vocational rehabilitation counselors, and other employment specialists** to the Discovery assessment process—a foundation for employment and career planning.

The session covers: how to structure and begin Discovery, selecting environments and activities for assessment, the employment team design, creating a sense of urgency, developing and recording information learned into the Discovery Staging Record, developing vocational themes, and more.

You will learn how important it is to get to know both the job seeker and the community and how essential it is to build community relationships through the Discovery process for job seekers with disabilities.
